GOLF GENIUS

We will be using Golf Genius for all Tuesday competitions and tournaments, including live scoring.

What does this mean for the members?

Members will need to download the Golf Genius App to their phone.

<u>Members will receive an "invitation" to sign up for a weekly competition or tournament</u> <u>online-no more paper signups.</u>

Only Active members (those who have paid their membership dues) will receive an invitation.

- For weekly competitions NOT monthly medals.
 - The member can sign up herself and one other member.
 - Members will be able to select their tee times.
 - Sign ups will be open on Monday morning, 8:00 am, the week before the day of play.
 - Sign ups will be closed on Sunday evening.
 - Until further notice, cancellations, and late signups (after the close on Sunday evening) will have to speak to the golf course staff.
- For monthly medals and tournament play:
 - The invitation will be a 'registration' and ask if you will be playing in the event.
 - Monthly medal schedule is same as Weekly comp open the Monday before the next week and closed on Sunday prior to the day of play.
- For Major tournaments, the invitation is typically sent out 3 weeks prior to the first tournament date and closes prior to the first day of play. Tournament chairs will determine which closing day works best for them—typically, Friday or Saturday before the tournament.
- Tee time selection is not an option and the Weekly Comp Chair, for monthly medals, and the Tournament chairs, for Major tournaments, will establish tee times.
 - Monthly Medal tee times are typically randomized across all handicaps.
 - o Tournament tee times are random within flights.

Members will use the Golf Genius Live Scoring app on their phones to record hole by hole scores.

• Golfers will use a GGID (<u>G</u>olf <u>G</u>enius <u>ID</u>) number that is unique to the foursome to log into the app to record the scores (live scoring).

• Tee sheets will be emailed to all participants either Sunday night or Monday morning. The tee sheet will have the GGID for each group.

- One person can record all scores of the group using your unique group GGID.
- A master written score card will be kept and turned in as a double check by the Captain.

• After the round, scores in the live scoring will be verified with your master scorecard and then signed, dated, and attested.

Golf Genius will post scores for all weekly and tournament competitions.

There will be a few glitches that have to be worked out

9-hole players. As of right now, GG has no way to distinguish an 18-hole player from a 9-hole player when signing up for the tee times. For now, we will request that the last 2 or 3 tee times (based on participation) be reserved for the 9-hole players. It is also requested that 9-hole players wait to enter their tee time in GG until Friday to give the 18-holers time to fill up the early times on the tee sheet.

Please remember, your GGID is unique to your group on that specific Tuesday. Your GGID will change every Tuesday. If you end up playing in a different group than the assigned tee time, you will need to enter your own score in GG using the GGID assigned and your new group will enter their scores with their unique GGID assigned. Please note this on the master written scorecard.

If you are playing other than MWGA Tuesday Competition, anywhere, you must <u>post</u> your score in the GHIN app to maintain an accurate handicap.
